Online Cross Objection Module:

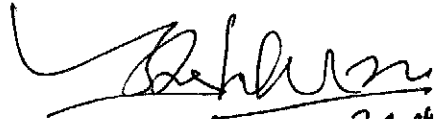
1. Cross objections are admissible only against the questions/answers against which objections have been received and listed below in objection chart.
2. It is emphasis that objections or cross objections on any new questions/answers will not be entertained.
3. Any candidate may file online cross objection(s) to any objected answer of his/her respective question booklet by sending E-mail as per following IDs:-

4. The cross objections are permissible only through E-mail. Cross Objection by way of hard copy, by hand or by post will not be entertained.
5. Filling of cross objection is permissible till **4.00 P.M on 01.05.2015**. No cross objection will be entertained in any eventuality after the given time. High Court shall not be responsible to maintain E-mail IDs after the expiry of time given for filing of cross objections.
6. Candidate shall type his/her name, roll number, booklet code and question no. in the subject box of the E-mail.
7. The cross objection shall be supported by reasons and be written in the space given in the E-mail. Before writing cross objection and reasons, candidate shall have to write the mandatory particular as under:-

- (a) Question No.....
- (b) High Court proposed Answer Key.....
- (c) Answer Key suggested by objector.....

8. Candidate can file cross objections to more than one objection. Only one cross objection will be entertained in one E-mail message. For next cross objection, candidate will have to send new E-mail message. Candidate can send as many E-mails as the cross objections preferred.
9. If candidate wants to support his/her cross objection by way of reference to any judgment or book, the complete citation of the judgment; title of the book, name of the Author, year or edition of publication, name of publisher and relevant page number must be mentioned in the cross objection. Further such judgment / relevant book page must be uploaded by way of attachment in PDF format only
10. The cross objections are being entertained in the interest of transparency, fairness and objectivity. Therefore, any attempt to play prank will be viewed seriously.
11. The High Court will not be responsible for any loss of contents, data, delay etc. due to any defect / fault.
12. No cross objection(s) submitted in violation of these instructions will be entertained at all.
