Sealed quotations are invited upto 23.02.18 for the supply of 43 Nos. Mobile Handsets and 43 Nos. Mobile Connections in each District in the States of Punjab, Haryana and U.T. Chandigarh clearly indicating the unit price inclusive of all charges, levies, taxes/GST etc. strictly as per the following terms and conditions:-

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:-

- 1. The Sealed Proposals addressed to "THE REGISTRAR (COMPUTERIZATION), PUNJAB AND HARYANA HIGH COURT, CAPITOL COMPLEX, SECTOR 1, CHANDIGARH" should reach in this Office latest by 23.02.18 till 5.00 PM. Any offer received thereafter will not be entertained. The word "Proposal for the supply of 43 Nos. Mobile Handsets and 43 Nos. Mobile Connections in each District in the States of Punjab, Haryana and U.T. Chandigarh" should be clearly inscribed on the top of the sealed envelope containing the Proposal.
- Rate should be quoted for unlimited incoming and outgoing calls, maximum free SMS facility (mention the number), internet data (mention GB) alongwith other services.
- 3. Rates of mobile handsets alongwith connection and without connection be also quoted by the vendors.
- 4. However, it is made clear here that merely quoting lowest rates will not entitle any offer for its acceptance rather decision with regard to the acceptance of the offer would be taken by the Hon'ble Computer/ Executive Committee after weighing proposal in its entirety e.g. specifications, quality of the product, suitability, goodwill of the firm, after sales services etc. The High Court reserves its right to reject any or all the proposals without assigning any reason.
- 5. The price should be inclusive of all taxes, freights, transit insurance, GST and F.O.R. each District Headquarter in the States of Punjab, Haryana and U.T. Chandigarh. The successful vendor is required to submit a certificate/undertaking to the effect that the rates are the lowest throughout India and it has not supplied the items of same specification and warranty to any other institution at the price lower than price charged from this Court and if this High Court came to know

at any stage that the firm has supplied at a price lower than what is charged from this High Court, the Company undertakes to charge the same rates and refund the excess amount, if any.

- 6. The firm should have arrangements for providing after-sale services immediately in each District in the States of Punjab, Haryana and U.T. Chandigarh. The vendor will be responsible for the comprehensive maintenance of all supplied equipments and related accessories free of charges during the warranty period.
- 7. No advance payment will be made under any circumstances.
- 8. Any question, dispute or difference arising under or concerning the deal, shall be referred to the Arbitrator, who shall be appointed by the Registrar General of this High Court. The award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. The venue of the arbitration shall be Chandigarh. The proceedings will be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the Rules made thereunder.
