

Terms & Conditions

1. The rates should be for Two Years AMC inclusive of all taxes, levies, GST etc.
2. While sending quotation, the word "Quotation for AMC of VC equipments installed in High Court" may be inscribed on the sealed envelope.
3. The Contract will be for Two years which may be renewed for further period of two more terms on the same terms and conditions, provided satisfactory services to the satisfaction of the High Court.
4. The payment will be released on Quarterly basis after completion of each quarter subject to satisfactory service during the relevant period.
5. The vendor will provide basic Preventive Maintenance every fortnight, so as to ensure that the equipments remain in good working condition.
6. The High Court can terminate the contract at any time by giving one month's notice.
7. Quotations received after due date will not be considered.
8. The High Court reserves the right to negotiate the price, accept or reject any proposal without assigning any reason.
9. Any question, dispute or difference arising under the contract shall be referred to the Arbitrator, who shall be appointed by the Registrar General of this High Court. The award of Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. The venue of the arbitration shall be Chandigarh. The proceedings will be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the Rules made there under.
10. That the Courts at Chandigarh alone shall have jurisdiction in all matters arising out of or connected with this Agreement.
